RE: REQUEST FOR DATA FOR PROCUREMENT AUDIT, SURVEILLANCE AND REVIEW

Please, recall that we had reason, by virtue of the statutory provisions of the Ondo State Public Procurement Law (ODPPL) 2017, to request for data for Procurement Audit, Surveillance and Review vide our circular letter Ref. No. ODBPP/OP/075/1 of 3rd January, 2020. For the benefit of doubt and, for emphasis, the circular letter is attached.

2. The essence of the data collated is to enable us meet a statutory requirement in the Law that makes it mandatory for the Bureau to submit Procurement Audit report to the Ondo State House of Assembly. Part II Section 5 (p) stipulates that:

The Bureau shall perform procurement audits and submit such report to the House of Assembly bi-annually

3. This circular is, therefore, a gentle reminder to you, as a procurement entity in Ondo State, to kindly comply with the ODPPL 2017 and furnish the Ondo State Bureau of Public Procurement (ODBPP) with full data on all 2019 benchmarks, ongoing capital projects and all contract awards made in 2019, whether completed or not, using the attached pro-forma. This submission should include all Direct Labour jobs and contract awards involving counterpart funding.

4. Extension is hereby granted to submit your data latest by Friday, 28th February, 2020 in hardcopy to the ODBPP office and softcopy to ondobpp@gmail.com. All other instructions in the first circular subsist. We, however, reiterate that, in the event that you do not comply, ODBPP may no longer entertain your requests for processing and a report will also be sent to Mt Governor.
